



METALLICA TO LIVE STREAM SATURDAY'S "THE NIGHT BEFORE" CONCERT IN SAN FRANCISCO

SAN FRANCISCO, CA – FEBRUARY 2, 2016 – On the eve of the nation's most anticipated sporting event, Rock and Roll Hall Of Fame inductees and Grammy® Award-winning rock band Metallica will headline CBS Radio's The Night Before, a one-of-a-kind concert experience the evening prior to Super Bowl 50 at AT&T Park in the band's hometown of San Francisco, CA. The concert marks the band's first performance of 2016.

Metallica fans around the world will be able to tune in to a live webstream direct from the historic show.
